

H.R. 3685

Promotion of the VetSuccess Internet Website

Title: To require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to include on the main page of the Internet website of the Department of Veterans Affairs a hyperlink to the VetSuccess Internet website and to publicize such Internet website.

Mr. Stearns introduced H.R. 3685 on September 30, 2009.

H.R. 3685 would:

- Direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to include on the main page of the Internet website of the Department of Veterans Affairs a hyperlink with a drop-down menu titled "Veterans Employment" that includes a direct hyperlink to the VetSuccess Internet website, USA Jobs Internet website, Job Central website, and any other appropriate employment Internet websites, especially those that focus on jobs for veterans.
- Authorize the purchase of advertising in national media outlets to promote awareness of the VetSuccess Internet website to veterans.
- Provide for outreach to veterans of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom to inform them of the VetSuccess Internet website.
